



Appendix B: Junior Cycle Schoolbooks Scheme Terms and Conditions

Errigal College will offer the Junior Cycle Schoolbooks Scheme introduced by the Department of Education to all Junior Cycle students.

The following terms and conditions apply to the Junior Cycle Schoolbooks Scheme for 2024-25:

1. If books are lost or damaged, students will be asked to pay part or full compensation to cover such loss or damage.
2. Purchase of pencils, pens and other necessary pencil case equipment will remain the responsibility of the students' parents/guardians.
3. The books supplied under the scheme will remain at all times the property of Errigal College. The items will be subject to inspection at any time by the Schoolbook Programme Coordinator or any member of the teaching staff.
4. Books supplied under the scheme may be new or second hand. It is the responsibility of the student to maintain the books allocated to him or her in the best possible condition.
5. It is not permitted to write on schoolbooks.
6. Lost schoolbooks or classroom resources given to students through the Junior Cycle Schoolbooks Scheme will not be replaced by the school.
7. The Junior Cycle Schoolbooks Scheme does not include any costs associated with Junior Cycle Mock Examinations.
8. Students will return the books for inspection at the end of each academic year. These will then be redistributed at the beginning of the next academic year.
